Harlay Avocats acts as counsel to Qantev in a €30 million fundraising

Qantev, a French start-up specializing in artificial intelligence for insurance data analysis, has raised €30 million to further its global expansion, recruit new talent and upgrade its platform.

Co-founded in 2019 by Tarik Dadi and Hadrien De March, Qantev continues to develop its scalable Al-based platform, which supports life and health insurers in their decision-making processes.

This fundraising is strategically significant, given the aging population, the increasing prevalence of chronic diseases and the rising medical costs. Qantev's suite of software solutions addresses these growing challenges in the healthcare sector by providing essential information to health insurance operational teams, thereby enabling improved management of reimbursements, effective cost control, and optimal service quality for members.

Led by Blossom Capital, with participation from longstanding investors Omnes, Raise and Elaia, this funding round brings the total amount raised by the company to over €40 million. Already operating in 19 countries and experiencing significant growth, Qantev will use this investment to strengthen and expand its international presence. The funding will also enable the recruitment of new talent, particularly from the fields of Al and engineering, while continuing the innovative development of the platform.
